

WHAT IS A VOTE CENTER?

A vote center gives the voter more flexibility because the eligible voter chooses which location works best for them to cast their ballot in the city or town.

Voters need to bring Government issued Photo ID to be eligible to vote.

Cambridge City and Milton

ONLY registered voters that live inside the town limits are eligible to vote in Town Elections

Vote Early at the Court House or the two vote centers in Richmond

Election Day - Cambridge City Voters can vote at Golay Center

Milton voters can vote at Milton Town Hall

Richmond Election only registered voters who live inside the city limits are eligible to vote. Voters can vote at any of the Richmond locations that are listed below
